

- ___ Trail Repair Assist park staff with trail repair projects. Move supplies to needed locations, widen trail with shovels or picks, install boards, remove rocks, and work on erosion control
Clear brush off trails, cut grass and weeds along hiking trails
- ___ Maintenance Repair and paint picnic tables
Staining and painting projects
Mowing lawn with riding mower
Small engine preventative maintenance
Remove brush and trees from prairie restoration areas in park
Road maintenance
- ___ Construction Carpentry related projects, roofing
Make wooden signs for trail markers and interpretive exhibits
Masonry work/repair
- ___ Volunteer Naturalists Harvest prairie seed to be used in other areas of the park
Assist naturalist in updating nature center exhibits
Nature Center greeter
Assist Naturalist in checking canoe trail signs each spring
Remove garlic mustard by hand, herbicide, or propane torch
Assist Naturalist with removal of trees off of Indian Mounds
Monitor bluebird trail in park every 7-10 days from May through August. Keep records of nesting activity, eggs, type of birds, remove house sparrow nests and eggs when found. Data recording forms will be provided
Update Park bulletin boards weekly
- ___ Friends of Wyalusing Assist with guided night hike in fall and ski event in winter
Serve as an officer or board member
Make firestarters for concession sales (currently full)
- ___ Adopt-a-Trail Service clubs or middle and high school youth groups
